

## Auburn Middle School

### Auburn, MA

Designed to support the district's team-based learning curriculum, the Auburn Middle School is organized into four clusters, each easily identifiable by its individual bright and distinctive color scheme. Three independent clusters, each with two teams of 90–100 students, are provided with core academic, special education and administrative support spaces. A fourth cluster accommodates Art, Technology, Receiving and Mechanical/Electrical rooms.

The central sky-lit lobby defines the separation of academic and community-use zones in the building. It serves as a foyer space for assembly use of the Gymnasium and Cafeteria, and as a means to introduce natural daylighting to interior spaces such as the Media Center and Administrative areas.
