Mt. Pleasant Elementary School

The new Mt. Pleasant Elementary School provides an innovative design for the replacement of an existing elementary school for the North Sanpete School District. The original school was built in the early 1960s and no longer met the needs of the school district. A new site was secured for the new elementary. Because of the unique terrain of the new site, the school was





elevated to incorporate the beautiful sunsets to the west and early morning sunrises with stunning mountain scapes to the east.

The school's main entry revolves around a clerestory commons area flooded with natural daylighting. The elevated administration and front area are set up to incorporate complete visibility as well as provide a secure vestibule to visually monitor or restrict access. The school's motto is "Where Dreams Take Flight,"

and the atmosphere of the school reflects this motto. The design provides learning environments with natural daylighting to inspire the students to achieve higher goals. The colorful patterns on the floors and throughout the design encourage creativity and excitement to learn. With integrated technology that provides a motivating environment, we aim to give all the students the opportunity to make their "dreams take flight."
