

## Princeton City Schools –Viking Village

### Cincinnati, OH

Princeton's new 555,000-square-foot campus makes a bold statement. Front and center of this campus is Viking Village, a space that features a collegiate-style lobby and collaborative spaces, two cafeterias separated by an operable glass wall, a 2,500-seat arena-style gymnasium, full-size natatorium, and state-of-the-art theater. Connecting the new middle and high schools, Viking Village serves grades 6–12 and plays host to many community events. Princeton's new campus was designed for the 22nd century, and Viking Village is no exception. Guided by the principles of engagement, adaptability, passion, and being student-centered, Princeton is prepared for education's evolution in the coming years.

With a focus on flexibility, the design team created spaces that can be used to create unique, collaborative environments. Princeton is also dedicated to use Viking Village to better serve the community. Designed for LEED Silver certification, the space includes daylighting, enhanced acoustics and a chilled-beam mechanical system. Community events will showcase that Viking Village is for everyone, leveraging specifically designed spaces in and around this staple for Princeton City Schools.
